Certificate of Filing and Recording Articles of Incorporation

To All to Whom these Presents May Come, Greeting:

Know Ye, *That whereas,* J. W. LAVALLEY, W. G. HOFFMAN and D. T.

BROWN,

having presented Articles of Incorporation of a Corporation organized and formed for scientific purposes, under and pursuant to the Laws of the State of Oregon, and paid the organization fee provided by "An Act to provide for the licensing of Domestic Corporations and Foreign Corporations, Joint Stock Companies and Associations, etc." approved February 16, 1903;

Now, Therefore, I, F. W. BENSON, Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, Do Hereby Certify, that said Articles of Incorporation have been filed and recorded in the office of the Secretary of State; that the name assumed by said corporation is

OREGON PEERLESS COLLEGE OF CHIROPRACTIC-NEUROPATHY,

the duration unlimited; the enterprise, business, pursuit or occupation of this corporation shall be the investigation, promotion, teaching, studying and spreading the science and art of Chiropractic-Neuropathy, to and among its members and any and all others who desire to become students thereof, and to confer the Degree of Doctor of Chiropractic-Neuropathy upon its graduates, which Degree shall be designated by the letters D.C-N.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of the Oregon Peerless College of Chiropractic-Neuropathy Society held at the offices of the College on the 6th day of March, 1911, the following Resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED That the President, J. E. Lavalley, Vice President, W. G. Hoffmann, and Secretary-Treasurer, D. T. Browne, of the Society, proceed at once to the incorporation of this Society under the statutes of the State of Oregon for the incorporation of Religious, Charitable and Educational Corporations, under the name of the Oregon Peerless College of Chiropractic-Neuropathy.

NOW, THEREFORE, We, J. E. Lavalley, W. G. Hoffmann and D. T. Browne, President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer of said Society, whose names are hereunto subscribed, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Oregon, for the incorporation of Religious, Charitable and Educational Societies.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this incorporation shall be the Oregon Peerless College of Chiropractic-Neuropathy, the duration thereof not being limited.

ARTICLE II.

The object, business and pursuit of this corporation shall be the investigation, promotion, teaching, studying and spreading the science and art of Chiropractic-Neuropathy, to and among its members and any and all others who desire to become students thereof, and to confer the Degree of Doctor of Chiropractic-Neuropathy upon its graduates, which Degree shall be designated by the letters D. C.-N.

ARTICLE III.

The value of the property possessed by this Society is One Thousand Dollars, and the source of revenue issued shall be the acceptance of donations and bequests, which may be made to or in behalf of this Society for the investigation, promotion, teaching, studying and spreading the science and art of Chiropractic Neuropathy and matriculation and graduation fees to be charged to and paid by students.

ARTICLE IV.

The title of the officers of this incorporation, shall be President, Vice President, Secretary Treasurer, and their successors shall be elected by ballot at regular annual meetings of the members thereof.

ARTICLE V.

The location of this Corporation shall be at Portland, Multnomah County, Oregon.


