

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: In a regular meeting all of the officers of Health Research Foundation (H.R.F.) met and considered proposals which had been presented by the Foundation for Accredited Chiropractic Education (FACE) and the N.C.A. Council on Education. And

WHEREAS: H.R.F. through Western States College(W.S.C.) has at all times met the highest academic standards in the chiropractic profession. And

WHEREAS: This has been done at great financial sacrifice by W.S.C. And

WHEREAS: F.A.C.E. was created and exists specifically for the purpose of aiding all N.C.A. colleges to attain academic standards at least equal to the statutory requirements of most of the United States. and

WHEREAS: The officers of W.S.C. worked loyally and diligently to help bring about Class A. affiliations between the N.C.A. and those states within the sphere of influence of W.C.S. and

WHEREAS: This goal was accomplished to an extent unequalled in any other region. and

WHEREAS: The N.C.A. members and state associations were assured that all the funds of F.A.C.E. were pledged to the support of all of the colleges accredited by the N.C.A. Council on Education. and

WHEREAS: Certain suggestions for relocation of some colleges were considered by the administrators of the N.C.A. colleges. and

WHEREAS: The officers of W.S.C. and H.R.F. have considered all of the proposals and hereby act upon those which pertain directly to the relationship existing between W.S.C. and F.A.C.E. and

WHEREAS: F.A.C.E. has requested that the name of Western States College be shared and divided with L.A.C.C. to be publicized in the future as Western States College, Northern Division and Southern Division. and

WHEREAS: The officers of H.R.F. recognizes that such indentification would tend to further strengthen the bonds of friendship and good working relationship which has always existed between these two colleges. and

WHEREAS: H.R.F. is desirous of continuing such negotiations until some plan can be presented which will be of mutual benefit to each of the colleges, their respective Alumni Associations, their supporting public, their legislative standings and which will best serve to perpetuate and enhance the growth of the chiropractic profession. and

WHEREAS: The officers of H.R.F. and W.S.C. have not had sufficient time or opportunity to agree on the many necessary details of such a reorganization. and

WHEREAS: The officers of H.R.F. and W.S.C. shall look forward to further conferences and to solicit the counsel and support of the officers of N.C.A. and F.A.C.E.

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED: That Dr. R. E. Elliot and Dr. M. I. Higgins are hereby authorized to represent Western States College and to enter into negotiations with the board of Foundation for Accredited Chiropractic Education(F.A.C.E.) for the purpose of stabilizing and advancing the status of chiropractic education in the geographic region known as N.C.A. District No. 1. which includes Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Alaska and the western provinces of Canada.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That their committments will be deemed as tentative until studied and approved by all of the officers and a majority of the Founder Members of H.R.F.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That their authority for committments shall equal but not exceed the authority for committments granted by the respective boards of the other colleges which are considered dispensable by the board of F.A.C.E. and the N.C.A. Council on Education.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the officers of H.R.F., representing well over two hundred active financial supporters of W.S.C., here and now again express their willingness to recognize the position of F.A.C.E. and to strive to meet its criteria.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the trustees of H.R.F. are pledged to sustain that mutual trust which continues to exist among the N.C.A. accredited colleges and to encourage all chiropractic colleges to seek such accreditation.
