

ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

The financial sacrifices made by ACA during the past seven years in the battle to establish quality education for qualified students has been worthwhile as best exemplified by the following statistics on enrollment and graduates.

In summary, new student enrollment is 25% above a year ago and the highest since Fall 1963 and total enrollment is 20% above a year ago and the highest since Fall 1966, keeping in mind that Lincoln and CINY statistics were included in those years.

We predict future growth in enrollment and graduates.
