

NOTICE ON ACCREDITATION STATUS

Re: Western States Chiropractic College

WHEREAS, the Western States College of Chiropractic was notified on January 12, 1964 that unless substantial correction of the deficiencies noted in the Bill of Particulars of July 25, 1963 were completed within six months following the January, 1964 notice, procedures for revoking the "Approved Conditionally" status would be implemented, and

WHEREAS, the report of the Director of Education following an inspection of Western States on June 9-11, 1964 showed a considerable change in conditions and progress toward meeting additional areas of the criteria, and

WHEREAS, exhibits furnished the Committee on Accreditation by the Western States College of Chiropractic served to substantiate these findings,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Western States College of Chiropractic be continued on the "Approved Conditionally" status.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Western States College of Chiropractic is hereby notified that unless continued substantial progress is made toward meeting the criteria and correcting the deficiencies which now exist during the next six months, the Committee on Accreditation will implement the procedures for the revocation of the "Approved Conditionally" status now enjoyed by the Western States College of Chiropractic.
