



Permit to Transact Business as a Dealer

Whereas, PACIFIC CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE

has made application to the Corporation Department of the State of Oregon for a permit to transact business as a Dealer in the State of Oregon, and has complied with the requirements of Chapter 324 of the General Laws of Oregon for 1915;

Now, Therefore, I, T. B. HANDLEY, Corporation Commissioner, by virtue of and pursuant to the authority in me vested by Chapter 341 of the General Laws of Oregon for 1913, as amended by Chapter 324 of the General Laws for 1915, do hereby give and grant permission unto the said PACIFIC CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE to transact business as a Dealer in the State of Oregon to sell \$20,000 of its capital stock, subject to the conditions set forth in the Department's letter of even date.
