ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
of  
HEALTH RESEARCH FOUNDATION

We, Alfred Budden, Ross H. Elliott and Elam Amstutz, all the officers and Trustees of Health Research Foundation, being desirous of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the state of Oregon as provided by Title XXV, Chapter IX Oregon Code 1930 as amended, do hereby execute in triplicate the following articles of incorporation:

I.

The name assumed by this corporation and the name by which it shall be known is HEALTH RESEARCH FOUNDATION and its duration shall be perpetual.

II.

The object, business and pursuit of this corporation shall be: To provide, without profit, for the advancement of the human healing arts and sciences; to improve the mental and physical well-being of its members and others; to provide proper facilities and equipment for the conduct of scientific research and experimentation in human health and healing; to collect or originate and publish data concerning methods of combatting and preventing human disease; to receive gifts, contributions, endowments and funds for the purpose of carrying out the objects herein mentioned and to defray the expenses incident thereto; to receive dues or fees from its members for the purpose of carrying out the objects herein set forth; to classify its members according to their respective periodical contributions of fees or dues, or otherwise, and to prescribe the voting right and eligibility to hold office of the several classes of members; to perform charitable healing services to such persons as its officers may from time to time in their discretion determine; to carry on programs of education among its members and others by publications, radio and otherwise;

to buy, purchase, own, sell, exchange, improve, rent, lease and mortgage real property, and to buy, purchase, own, sell, exchange, improve, rent, lease, mortgage, pledge and hypothecate personal property and mixed property in so far as the same is necessary and incidental to carrying out the objects herein set forth; to operate and maintain libraries, laboratories, hospitals and clinics; to provide housing and facilities for the members of the corporation and other kindred and like organizations, incorporated and unincorporated, and carrying out the objects herein set forth; and to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges conferred by the laws of the State of Oregon.

### III.

The estimated value of property and money possessed by this organization at the time of making these articles of incorporation is nothing and the sources of revenue and income are dues and fees of its members and gifts, contributions, endowments and funds of its members and other individuals and organizations of every kind that are inclined to advance and carry out the objects of this corporation as hereinbefore set forth.

### IV.

The title of the officers and trustees making these articles and their postoffice addresses are as follows:

Alfred Sudden, President and Trustee, Portland, Oregon.

Elam Anstutz, Secretary and Trustee, Gresham, Oregon.

Ross H. Elliott, Treasurer and Trustee, Portland, Oregon.

The mode and times of election of their successors in office is and are as follows: The present trustees and officers shall hold their trusteeship and respective offices for the period of time from the issuance of the charter to and including the first Monday of November, 1938, and on the first Monday of November of each year their successors

in office shall be elected and qualified. The trustees and officers shall be chosen from among the "Governors" of the membership as they are to be defined in the by-laws of this corporation and a majority of the vote of the said "Governors" shall be sufficient for the election of trustees and officers.

V.

The location of said organization shall be in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon.
