

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the members of the Board of Trustees of the Health Research Foundation in meeting in regular session on November 7, 1969 have been appraised of the financial emergency that presently exists at Western States Chiropractic College, and

WHEREAS, this Board has been charged with the responsibility of maintaining Western States Chiropractic College as a College that hopefully will gain accreditation in the very near future, and

WHEREAS, the practitioners in the State of Oregon have maintained a Class A affiliation with the American Chiropractic Association for a number of years, wherein members of our Association have been participating in the support of other schools but have, for the past five years, have had no financial support from the parent organization, and

WHEREAS, Western States Chiropractic College has been one of the earliest schools to ^{implement a} maintain the two-year pre-professional requirement to upgrade the profession of Chiropractic,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the HEALTH RESEARCH FOUNDATION (dba WESTERN STATES CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE) hereby request that the college administrator, Dr. Robert E. Elliot, respectfully submit to the Board of FCER an emergency request in the amount of \$15,000 to be utilized in the areas budgeted in his letter to the FCER Board, which is tendered with this resolution to Dr. A. M. Schierholz.
