RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION REGARDING WESTERN STATES CHIROPRACTIC COLLEGE

The following three minimum steps for continuation of Recognized Candidate for Accreditation status were specified in a resolution of the Commission on Accreditation dated January 18, 1980:

1. A certified audit as of December 31, 1979 be submitted to the Commission;
2. A reconciliation and/or comparison between the existing financial condition and all requisite standards for financial stability be provided; and,
3. An analysis of the change in these data between the June 30, 1979 denial date and the December 31, 1979 audit be submitted to the Commission.

Subsequent to this resolution, a modification in the audit date from December 31, 1979 to March 31, 1980 was authorized.

The foregoing steps have been satisfactorily concluded with the timely receipt of the necessary documents.

Analysis and interpretation of the submitted data discloses the following conditions:

1. Substantial improvement in the financial status of the College has been demonstrated since the denial of initial accreditation on June 20, 1979 as represented by a reduction in current debt and notes, contracts and mortgage payable in an aggregate amount of \$114,108, such reduction made possible primarily from government grants and gifts (See attached exhibit of Fund Flow Analysis).
2. Significant steps have been taken to increase efficiency of college operations and to discontinue ancillary functions of the college which have been a cash drain on resources.
3. Current operations and financial status approach the financial guidelines for full accreditation and show promise for conformance by the annual meeting in 1981 as specified in the January 1980 resolution.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that upon withdrawal of the appeal on the denial of initial accreditation by the college, the Commission on Accreditation will continue Recognized Candidate for Accreditation status for Western States Chiropractic College for a period no longer than the annual meeting in 1981. A new self-study application shall be submitted by August 1, 1980.
