RESOLUTION

23 JANUARY 1981

Western States Chiropractic College

WHEREAS, Western States Chiropractic College submitted a self-study in application for accredited status to the Commission on Accreditation, and

WHEREAS, The Commission on Accreditation sent an evaluation team to visit the Western States Chiropractic College on November 3, 4 and 5, 1980; and

WHEREAS, The evaluation team submitted a report of its findings to the Commission on Accreditation which was considered at a hearing on January 23 1981;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Commission on Accreditation hereby grants the Western States Chiropractic College Accredited status for a period of three years;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that progress reports are to be submitted on a semi-annual basis and these reports should concern themselves with the weaknesses noted in the evaluation team report with special consideration to the following concerns:

1. Excessive reliance upon tuition to meet educational and general expenses.
2. Need to expend more effort to delegate responsibilities presently concentrated with the chief administrator
3. Need for greater attention to long range planning
4. Lack of faculty involvement in research
5. Greater need for post-graduate involvement.
