

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Western States Chiropractic College submitted a Self-Study to the Commission on Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education as its application for accredited status, and

WHEREAS, a Council on Chiropractic Education visitation team evaluated the Western States Chiropractic College on February 26 - March 1, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Commission on Accreditation held a hearing on June 21, 1978 on the application of Western States Chiropractic College for accreditation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education has found that Western States Chiropractic College is not in compliance with the Council on Chiropractic Education Standards under the following headings:

1. Objectives - there is a lack of clear definition of said objectives in the "Western States Chiropractic College Update and Self-Evaluation Report,"
2. Financial Management - There is a need to address both the organizational and substantive aspects of financial management as noted in the team report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education is concerned with:

1. The organization and corporate structure of Western States Chiropractic College,
2. The stability of the Western States Chiropractic College's Administration and Faculty in light of the events following the Council on Chiropractic Education's team visit of February 26 - March 1, 1978,
3. The qualitative aspect of the clinical experience, particularly with regard to laboratory, physical exam and x-ray,
4. The fact that research is only in the planning stage and is not in evidence at a level necessary for an accredited institution.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation would further call the attention of the institution to the weaknesses and concerns noted in the visitation team report of March 1, 1978.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation does hereby defer its decision on granting initial accreditation to Western States Chiropractic College.

Western States Chiropractic College is hereby granted a maximum of one year to demonstrate compliance with the Council on Chiropractic Education's criteria of Objectives and Financial Management and to demonstrate correction of areas of concern noted above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Western States Chiropractic College submit quarterly progress reports to the Commission with respect to fullfillment of the terms of this Resolution.
