RESOLUTION

January 27, 1979

WHEREAS, the Commission on Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education adopted a resolution at the June, 1978 Commission meeting on the application of the Western States Chiropractic College for initial accreditation and,

WHEREAS, the Western States Chiropractic College submitted documents in response to the resolution,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation of the Council on Chiropractic Education continues to defer its decision on granting initial accreditation to the Western States Chiropractic College and cites this concern:

Evidence from the documents provided the Commission on Accreditation do not clearly or definitively demonstrate compliance with these areas from the June, 1978 Commission on Accreditation Resolution

- stability of the administration and faculty
- qualitative aspect of clinical experience
- level of research

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Accreditation does hereby assign an Evaluation Team, consisting of Drs. Victor Hurst and John Allenburg, to visit the institution for the purpose of determining compliance with the June, 1978 Resolution.
