In light of the most recent revaluations concerning our continuing difficulty in obtaining CCE accreditation, the Student Council wishes it to be known that it will continue to contribute time, money, equipment, and effort to full accreditation with CCE and the promotion of the Chiropractic profession and continuing improvements of the academic and clinical experience for students of the college.

We can no longer, however, lend support to the attitudes and consistent lack of leadership that we feel has contributed to the declining spirit and resources of the college as a whole. Particularly, we find the lack of direction and leadership from the office of the President and Dean of Administration to be less than acceptable to the high standards needed for the college and the profession.

We express this opinion with sadness and regret but we feel the time has come to be honest with the professional community to which we have dedicated our lives.
